Britain at War & Classroom Capers Join Forces to Create First World War Centenary Resources for UK Schools

The UK's best-selling military history title, Britain at War Magazine and classroom resources supplier, Classroom Capers, have joined forces to launch a commemorative, First World War school poster to mark the centenary of this significant event in UK history.

Targeted primarily at Key Stage 2 and 3 students, the poster aims to commemorate the 100 year anniversary and bring this historic event to life by summarising the major aspects of the war in both words and photography.
